

FIGHTING THE WVU FLU OUTBREAK

OVERVIEW:

West Virginia University's basketball team was unable to train due to a lack of players - an influenza outbreak had caused a significant amount of student absences, including athletes. Panhandle Cleaning and Restoration were called in to assist the school to help the team get back on track.

SCOPE OF WORK:
